Resident Council Minutes

FOOD COMMITTEE

Laura O. greeted the group and asked how the food has been, including meals, snacks, and the menu options. One positive comment came forward. Laura O. asked the group to help her plan the June BBQ meal and the July 4th noon meal. Residents agreed on BBQ menu: Brats, baked beans, potato salad, watermelon, ice cream sandwich, lemonade/ iced tea. For the 4th of July menu: Cheese burgers, baked beans, fries, coleslaw, and pie (strawberry rhubarb pie?). One resident mentioned the kitchen staff deserve kudos as they are doing great and very helpful! He added the chicken breasts that day were dry and hard to cut. One resident mentioned the German potato salad should be hot, not cold. Laura took note. Laura asked if there were any other comments. None came forward.

DISCUSSION OF OLD BUSINESS

Laura read over the previous month's minutes and noted it was a shorter meeting. Laura asked all how they liked the Memorial Day meal. Positive comments came forward. 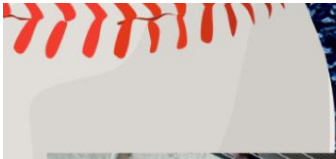
- ***Jackie, HUC**- “She has been kicking butt and holding the department down for both floors!!” -Assistant DON

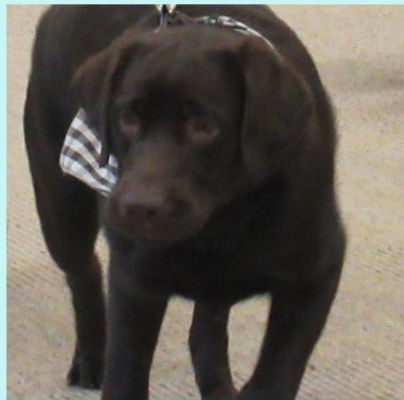

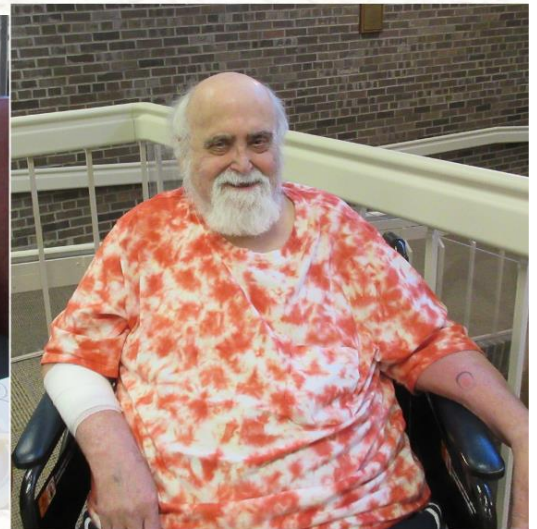






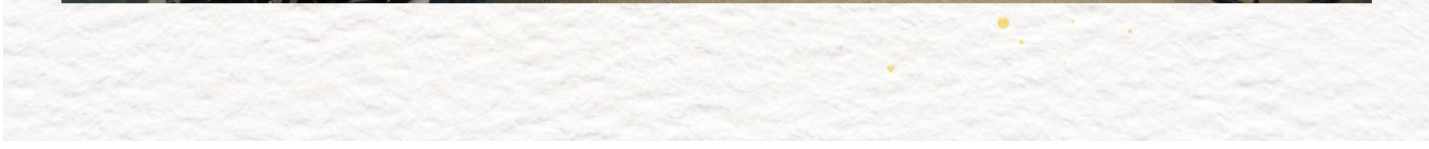
